Agenda Item 5 – New Business

- a) Discussion and possible action on request from 801 E. Wisconsin Avenue to reduce sewer charges due to toilet leak.

Mr. Platt of 801 E. Wisconsin Ave wrote a letter stating that after he received his large 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter bill he discovered and repaired a toilet leaking in an unused basement bathroom and he is requesting removal of the sewerage charges. The sewer charge for 100,972 gallons was \$609.87. After a lengthy discussion Miller moved, seconded by Mertens to reduce the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter sewer bill by 10%. Motion carried 4-0.

- b) Discussion and possible action on proposal to install radar speed sign on Lake Street at Richmond Drive.

DPW White stated that Trustee Gergen has stated that she has received numerous complaints about speeding traffic from residents along Lake Street from Lookout Drive to Prospect Avenue. In response to these complaints, the Village Police Department has setup radar patrol 48 times since the beginning of the school year to monitor traffic along Lake Street. Setting up mainly during the PM school traffic exit timeframe, The PD has issued 4 citations during those setups.

After a lengthy discussion about the installation of a radar speed sign being placed near Lake and Richmond, Mertens moved, seconded by Nauth to recommend to the Village Board that a radar speed sign be installed on Lake Street. Motion carried 4-0.
