Re: 2019 Spring Street Reconstruction

Dear Spring Street Resident,

This letter is to notify you that beginning approximately May 6th, contractor D.F. Tomasini and its subcontractors will begin the reconstruction of Spring Street. The project is anticipated to take until approximately early August to complete, weather permitting. The work currently taking place is being conducted by We Energies gas division, please direct questions on that work directly to the contractor or We Energies.

The project will begin with installation of underground utilities, including sanitary sewer, water main, and storm sewer which will take until about the end of June. That will be followed by road base preparation, installation of curb and gutter, paving, and final restoration. You will generally continue to have regular access to your driveway until the installation of curb and gutter and driveway approaches, during which time you will not have access for 1 to 2 weeks, weather depending. We will provide a notice of when your vehicles will need to be removed from the driveway.

- Work will start at 7AM. Please do not park on the street during working hours during the project. There will be times of noise, dust, uneven driving surfaces, and truck back up beepers.
- When the contractor is working near you, please limit your number of trips in the work zone as it may slow the contractor's progress and can create danger to you and the workers. Work stopping for the day in front your property may not allow access to your driveway.
- Advanced Waste requests that all garbage carts on Spring Street be placed on the even (south) side of the street, and are out for collection by 6:00 am. They will collect before contractor work begins for the day.
- Some portions of the project will require water service interruptions. We will provide notice the previous day when possible.
- You may park on adjacent streets where parking is allowed, and the Police Department will not enforce parking and overnight restrictions near the project.
- Please remind children to stay away from the construction site and equipment.

School bus pick up location(s) will likely be changing. Please contact Riteway at 691-9868 for what they may change until school is out in June.

If you have any construction related questions call me at 691-5694. A construction inspector representing the Village will be present on site throughout the work to assist you or answer questions. If you have an accommodation or access concern that needs consideration, do not hesitate to ask the contractor or inspector.
