To all Village of Pewaukee Residents and Businesses:

As you are likely aware, the Wisconsin Supreme Court overturned the Governor's Safer at Home order effective May 14, 2020. At this time, there are no restrictions in place by the State of Wisconsin with the exception that the order relating to the closure of schools remains in effect.

What does this mean? The Wisconsin Legislature and the Governor may come up with a substitute order regarding COVID-19 at a state level. When or if this happens is unknown.
